Course requirements

Summary

You will be participating in your Alaska Close Up session with the other students in the program. You will complete all advance assignments, and all lessons assigned during the session. You will write a short journal and evaluation, to be completed within two weeks of the end of the session.

- 1 Complete the advance assignments, including the extra credit assignments. (Web site: www.serrc.org/academy)
- 2 Work with your fellow students and your teacher as you prepare for the regional presentation and local project.
- 3 Attend and participate in all the student activities for the session.
- 4 Complete a journal/evaluation of the Alaska Close Up session, and mail or FAX it to the instructor within two weeks of the end of your session.

Alaska Close Up Journal contents:

- a. Describe the effectiveness of the Alaska Close Up web site and assignments in preparing you for your Alaska Close Up experience.
- b. For each day, Sunday through Friday, write two or three paragraphs that discuss one or more of the following:
 - Major concepts you learned about state government
 - The learning activities that taught you the most about government
 - General evaluation of the positive and negative aspects of the day
- c. Discuss how your overall Alaska Close Up experience has influenced your perception of state government.
